### ***Exploring the Truth and Fiction in Mythology***

From the times of the first pictographs to modern times, man has always been intrigued by mythology. All through time, mythology has served to explain concepts beyond our comprehension. Beginning in January, the popular historian, Bryant Kumlin, will return to Living Waters Church of Lino Lakes to help us understand how mythology has played a key role in mankind's understanding of our world through the centuries. Here is Mr. Kumlin's schedule of topics and dates:

January 9: What is mythology? What does it encompass and why study it?

January 16: Egyptian mythology—4000BC to 300BC—Understanding the creation of the earth, early legends and the afterlife

January 23: Early Middle Eastern Mythology—Mythology becomes categorized, how they form the basis of religions, and their influence on early Jewish people.

January 30: Greek and Roman Mythology—How they are different and what makes them similar

February 6: Modern Mythology—Folklore, urban legends, and how we still use mythology today

Each of these Wednesday evenings will begin with worship vespers from 6:30 to 7 p.m. followed by Kumlin's presentation from 7 to 8. This worship and lecture series is open to the public and free of charge.
